ORDER AUTHORIZING CHANGE OF ELECTRIC SERVICE PROVIDER

On September 28, 1998, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL), Missouri Public Service, a Division of UtiliCorp United, Inc. (MoPub), Clinton Markt Meyer, Shavonne Danner Cozad and Scott Cozad (Applicants), filed an Application for Change of Electric Service Provider. Applicants' application indicates that Clinton Markt Meyer, Shavonne Danner Cozad and Scott Cozad (Customers) are the owners of a tract of land located within KCPL's certificated territory on which the construction of multiple residences is contemplated. KCPL does not have existing facilities in place to serve Customers' property. Customers' property is adjacent to MoPub's certificated service territory. Applicants request that the Commission change the electric service provider for Customers' property from KCPL to MoPub.

On November 5, Staff filed its recommendations regarding Applicants' application. Staff's memorandum indicates that it has reviewed the application and recommends approval of the application.

Upon review of the application and the Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the proposed transfer of service is in the public interest. MoPub has electric facilities in the area, is in a position to provide service to Applicants, is willing to provide those services, and KCPL concurs.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the electric service provider for the tract of land described in the application is changed from Kansas City Power & Light Company to Missouri Public Service, a Division of UtiliCorp United, Inc.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on November 5, 1998.
- 3. That Staff shall file a memorandum advising the Commission when the change of electric service provider has been completed and Missouri Public Service, a Division of UtiliCorp United, Inc. is providing electric service.


