ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

The Commission granted Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE) and Crawford Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s joint application for approval of a written territorial agreement on January 28, 1999. The order directed AmerenUE to file revised tariff sheets consistent with the territorial agreement. AmerenUE filed the required tariff sheets on February 19. On March 10, March 12 and March 15, AmerenUE filed substitute sheets and by cover letter dated March 15, AmerenUE indicated only the March 15 filing should be considered by the Commission.

The Commission's Staff reviewed the tariff sheets and filed a memorandum on March 16 recommending that the Commission approve the tariffs as filed on February 19 and substituted on March 15. Staff stated that the tariff sheets comply with the Commission's ordered paragraph 2 and should be approved to become effective on March 22.

Having reviewed the tariff sheets and the Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the tariff sheets conform to the Commission's order and should be approved to become effective on March 22.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE on February 19, 1999, are approved as amended to become effective on March 22, 1999. The tariff sheets approved are:
