

**ORDER DISMISSING MOTION**

On January 18, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion opening a case to amend 4 CSR 240-123.040 to update the name of the Department of Manufactured Homes and Modular Units (formerly "mobile homes division") and to clarify admission requirements. On July 25, 2000, Staff filed its Motion for Finding of Necessity for Rulemaking with a memorandum attached in support of its motion. In the motion of July 25, 2000, Staff states that the purpose of the proposed rulemaking is to clarify the requirements for identifying model names and system change proposals as well as updating the name of the Department of Manufactured Homes and Modular Units. The proposed rulemaking will also increase the fee charged for plan approvals from \$50 to \$75. On August 22, 2000, the Commission issued its Order Finding Necessity for Rulemaking authorizing Staff to proceed with the proposed rulemaking.


On October 27, 2000, the Staff filed its Motion for Finding of Necessity for Rulemaking with a memorandum attached in support of its motion. This motion appears duplicative of Staff's July 25, 2000, motion that the Commission previously granted. There is no need for the Commission to address this motion a second time. Therefore the motion will be dismissed.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the motion filed by Staff on October 27, 2000, is dismissed. The order of the Commission issued on August 22, 2000, remains in effect.
2. That this order shall become effective on December 30, 2000.
