ORDER APPROVING INTERIM BOWLING GREEN DISTRICT RATES

United Cities Gas Company (United) of Franklin, Tennessee, submitted a tariff sheet to the Commission on December 21, 1998, carrying an effective date of February 1, 1999. On January 19, 1999, United filed a substitute tariff sheet to correct a typographical error. The tariff sheet was filed to reflect a change in the Bowling Green District's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factor as a result of an increase in the spot market cost of gas. This change will increase United's annualized revenues by approximately \$18,200. The impact on a typical residential space heating customer using 217 Ccf of natural gas in the month of February will be an increase of \$2.55 or 2.0%.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum stating that the change in United's PGA was calculated in conformance with United's approved PGA Clause and recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheet to become effective on February 1, 1999. Staff recommends that the tariff sheet be approved on an interim basis, subject to refund, until the Commission makes its final determinations in Case Nos. GR-98-274 and GR-99-280.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the tariff sheet conforms to its Commission-approved PGA Clause

and is therefore reasonable. After considering Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff sheet should be approved to become effective on and after the requested effective date of February 1, 1999, interim subject to refund.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheet submitted on December 21, 1998, as substituted on January 19, 1998, by United Cities Gas Company of Franklin, Tennessee, for the purpose of reflecting changes in rates for natural gas in its Bowling Green District, is approved on an interim basis, subject to refund, to become effective on February 1, 1999.
