ORDER CANCELING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Kelley S. Beddow and Brian S. Beddow, d/b/a Universal Telephone (Universal) filed an application on August 10, 1998, requesting a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services in the State of Missouri, and requesting competitive classification. The Commission granted intervention to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) on August 27. A procedural schedule was adopted by order of the Commission entered on October 27.

On January 5, 1999, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion asking that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule because the parties had been able to resolve the outstanding issues in the case. A Stipulation and Agreement signed by Universal, SWBT and Staff was filed on January 5. The filing of the Stipulation and Agreement renders the previously adopted procedural schedule unnecessary.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

 That the procedural schedule previously adopted in this case is canceled.

- 2. That the evidentiary hearing scheduled for January 15, 1999 is canceled.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on January 15, 1999.
