## ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE TECHNICAL REVISIONS TO DIRECT TESTIMONY

On September 1, 1998, the Staff of the Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Motion for Extension of Time to File Technical Revisions to Direct Testimony with the Commission. Staff stated in support of its motion that because of errors discovered in its computer run, Staff was unable to file its supplemental rate design testimony by the deadline. Staff requested an extension of time and asked that it be permitted to file the technical revisions to Direct Testimony as soon as possible but no later than September 9. The Revised Direct Testimony of Staff Witness Wendell R. Hubbs was filed on September 9.

The Commission received no objection from the other parties within ten days as permitted for response pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(12). The Commission finds that an extension of time to file the technical revisions to direct testimony is reasonable and Staff's motion shall be granted.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Motion for Extension of Time to File Technical Revisions to Direct Testimony filed by the Staff of the Public Service Commission shall be granted.

2. That this order shall be effective on October 5, 1998.


