ORDER REGARDING CASE STATUS

On April 22, 1994, the case record reflects that an implementation plan prepared by The Raytown Water Company was filed by William K. Haas, Assistant General Counsel, on behalf of the Staff of the Missouri Public Commission Service (Staff). Staff indicated that it was not requesting an on-the-record conference in this case. Deputy Chief Regulatory Law Judge Anne Wickliffe was notified that an implementation review was to be completed by December 1997.

The Commission has not received a report regarding implementation of the management audit or review of the implementation plan. The Commission would find it helpful in moving this case towards closure to receive a schedule from the Staff indicating the completion date of the implementation review and an expected date for filing of the implementation report. The Commission will also find it helpful for the Staff to outline by date or time period any further action that it expects to be necessary in this case before this case may be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission file its report advising the Commission of a schedule for completing the implementation review and

filing the implementation report. Further, Staff shall notify the Commission in its report of any other action that it expects to be necessary prior to closing of this case.

- 2. That Staff's report shall be filed with the Commission by September 30, 1998.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on August 18, 1998.
