ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On August 7, 1998, the parties filed a unanimous Joint Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule and to Extend Diagnostic Period. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. That the following procedural schedule is established for this case:
