ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

The Commission issued an order approving an interconnection agreement and assignment of rights between the parties to this case on September 22, 1998. The Commission also directed the parties to submit a "snap-back" agreement in compliance with the order no later than October 5, 1998. GTE Midwest Incorporated and GTE Arkansas Incorporated (GTE) filed a Motion for Extension of Filing Deadline on October 2 stating that GTE needs additional time to complete the snap-back agreement filing. GTE stated that its representatives have been engaged in continuing discussions with the Commission Staff and need the additional time in order to satisfy Staff concerns. GTE stated that Green Hills Area Cellular Telephone Company, the other party to the agreement, has agreed to the requested extension.

The Commission has reviewed the motion and finds it is reasonable. Accordingly, the extension to October 12, 1998 will be granted as requested.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the deadline for the filing of a snap-back agreement is extended from October 5 to October 12, 1998.
 - 2. That this Order shall become effective on October 9, 1998.
