ORDER DENYING STAY

On August 31, 2000, the Commission issued its Report and Order in this matter. Thereafter, on September 13, 2000, applications for rehearing were filed by Missouri-American Water Company, Office of the Public Counsel, the City of Joplin, the City of St. Joseph, the St. Joseph Area Public Water Supply District Intervenors, the St. Joseph Industrial Intervenors, together with the City of Riverside, and Gilster Mary-Lee Corporation. Additionally, the St. Joseph Industrial Intervenors, Gilster Mary-Lee Corporation and the St. Joseph Area Public Water Supply District Intervenors each filed an application for a stay or, alternatively, that the increased revenue under Missouri-American Water Company's new water service tariffs be collected subject to an obligation of refund.

The Commission has considered the requests for a stay and the alternative requests that rates be collected under an obligation of refund. These will be denied. Missouri-American Water Company is providing water service to its customers and its new construction is in service. Therefore, it is only right that the Company receive appropriate revenues

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Applications for a Stay or, in the Alternative, that Rates be Collected Subject to an Obligation of Refund, filed on September 13, 2000, by the St. Joseph Industrial Intervenors, Gilster Mary-Lee Corporation and the St. Joseph Area Public Water Supply District Intervenors, are denied.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on September 19, 2000.
