### ORDER AUTHORIZING CHANGE OF SUPPLIER

On October 23, 2000, Myer Hotels, Inc. (Myer), White River Valley Electric Cooperative (White River), and The Empire District Electric Company (Empire; collectively, Applicants) filed a joint application pursuant to Sections 393.106 and 393.315, RSMo 1994, seeking authorization of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) for a change of electric service provider from Empire to White River for an existing structure on property under development.

The joint application states that the change of electric service provider for Myer will be in the public interest. Applicants explain that construction in the area would require White River to relocate existing lines, and that White River is prohibited from serving new or additional customers in the area. The proposed change of supplier would allow White River to abandon the existing lines, and allow Empire to serve the existing structure and the new development.

On November 13, 2000, the Staff of the Commission filed its Memorandum in which it recommends approval of the application. Staff agrees with the Applicants that it is in the public interest to allow the change of electric supplier.



Upon review of the application and the Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the proposed transfer of Myer from White River to Empire is in the public interest. The Commission will approve the transfer.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Myer Hotels, Inc. may change electric suppliers as requested in the application from White River Valley Electric Cooperative to The Empire District Electric Company.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on December 15, 2000.


