**ORDER ADOPTING REPORT AND CLOSING CASE**

On July 5, 1995, the Commission issued a Report And Order in which it adopted a geographic split of the current 314 Numbering Plan Area (NPA) to remedy the exhaustion of central office codes (NXXs) in the 314 NPA. Also in that Report And Order, the Commission established a technical committee to address certain issues involving the boundary between the 314 NPA and the new 573 NPA, to address issues involving cellular customers, and to establish a permissive dialing period.

The technical committee filed a report on July 27, 1995, in which it provided three alternatives to the Commission for addressing the boundary questions. The Commission issued its order adopting one of the three alternatives on August 4, 1995.

On September 25, 1995, the technical committee filed a final report indicating the resolution of the other issues. The Commission has reviewed that report and finds that it provides reasonable solutions to the issues involving cellular customers and the permissive dialing period. Specifically, the report indicates that the parties have agreed to a permissive dialing period beginning at 11:59 p.m. on January 7, 1996, and continuing until 11:59 p.m. on July 7, 1996. The report indicates that the 314 numbers of cellular customers who will be located in the 573 NPA after July 7, 1996, will have an extended period to

switch their cellular telephones to the new 573 NPA. All cellular customers located within the new 573 NPA will be switched by March 31, 1997.

The Commission finds that the technical committee's report resolves all outstanding issues and the Commission will adopt the report and close these cases.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the report of the technical committee in this case filed September 25, 1995, is hereby adopted.
2. That Case Nos. TO-95-289 and TO-95-290 are closed.
3. That this order shall become effective on the 11th day of October, 1995.
