ORDER APPROVING ACTUAL COST ADJUSTMENT

On April 19, 1994, Union Electric Company (UE) filed its 1993-94 actual cost adjustment for the period from May 1993 through March 1994. An audit of this filing was conducted by the Staff of the Commission. On February 10, 1995, the Staff filed its recommendation regarding adjustments to the proposed ACA filing. On March 13, 1995, UE filed its response in which it concurred with the final adjustments proposed by the Staff.

In its recommendation, and as a result of the Staff audit, adjustments were made in the account balances for operation of propane infusion plants, gas costs, the costs of operating UE's combustion turbine facility in Cape Girardeau, and in various miscellaneous omitted gas costs. These adjustments resulted in the following recommendation by the Staff in the ACA account balances:


In its response UE offered several corrections to the Staff calculations, to which the Staff agreed. None of the proffered corrections affected the proposed Staff adjustments. UE concurred in the final Staff adjustments as proposed in the Staff recommendation.

Based on the Staff recommendation, as corrected by agreement and to which both parties concur, the Commission determines that the proposed Staff adjustments as set out in the Staff recommendation of February 10, 1995, are accurate, reasonable, and will be approved for collection or refund from the ratepayers in UE's next ACA filing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the above set out ACA balances for the period from May 1993 through March 1994 are approved for collection or refund by Union Electric Company in its next ACA filing.
2. That this docket is closed.
