ORDER APPROVING AGREEMENTS

On August 29, 1994, Missouri Cities Water Company (Missouri Cities) filed an application seeking Commission approval of several "Termination of Water Service Agreements" (agreements). The agreements are contracts entered into pursuant to Section 393.015, RSMo (Supp. 1993), whereby the water service provided by Missouri Cities may be discontinued for nonpayment of a bill for sewer service.

Missouri Cities has entered into agreements with the Cities of St. Charles, Missouri; Brunswick, Missouri; Mexico, Missouri; O'Fallon, Missouri; Parkville, Missouri; Platte Woods, Missouri; Riverside, Missouri; St. Peters, Missouri; and Warrensburg, Missouri; as well as the Platte County Sewer District. Missouri Cities states the contracts have language identical to the agreements approved by the Commission in Case Nos. WO-93-298 and WD-95-1 except for charges based on actual cost.


On September 15, 1994, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve the proposed agreements. Staff also recommended that Missouri Cities be authorized to file tariff sheets consistent with its application.

Upon review of the application, the agreements, and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the proposed agreements are reasonable and in compliance with Section 393.015, RSMo (Supp. 1993). Thus, the Commission determines that the agreements filed by Missouri Cities should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the "Termination of Water Service Agreements" filed in this case by Missouri Cities Water Company are hereby approved.
2. That Missouri Cities Water Company shall file tariff sheets consistent with the application and this Order within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Order.
3. That this Order shall become effective on October 4, 1994.
