ORDER APPROVING ORIGINAL TARIFF

On February 16, 1990, the Commission granted Highway H Utilities, Inc.
(Company) a certificate and ordered it to file tariffs. On March 14, 1990, the
Company submitted its tariffs for Commission approval.

On April 5, 1990, Staff filed a memorandum recommending the Commission
approve the tariffs filed. Staff stated that it believes the tariffs are
reasonable except they contain no rule governing the extension of water mains.
Staff also stated that Company had verbally agreed to file an extension rule.
Staff further stated that since the Company was already in operation, it
recommended the Commission approve the tariffs filed and allow Staff to work
with the Company in filing a main extension rule.

The Commission has reviewed the tariffs and the recommendation of its
Staff. The Commission has determined that Company should not construct any
extension of a water main until it has filed, and the Commission has approved, a
rule governing such construction. The Commission has also determined that the
Company should file a water main extension rule within 30 days of the effective
date of this order.

The Commission is of the opinion that the tariffs submitted March 14, 1990, comply with its Report and Order issued February 16, 1990, and said tariff sheets should be allowed to become effective on and after April 13, 1990.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the tariff sheets submitted March 14, 1990, by Highway H Utilities, Inc., for the purpose of establishing rates and rules for the provision of water service in certain portions of Pulaski County, Missouri, are hereby approved and made effective for water service on and after April 13, 1990.

ORDERED: 2. That Highway H Utilities, Inc. is hereby ordered to file a tariff governing the construction of water main extensions within 30 days of the effective date of this order.
