ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On May 28, 1991, Missouri Telephone Company (MoTel) submitted to the Commission a proposed tariff to establish a 60 day waiver of the \$4.35 service connection charge for installing of custom calling features as those become available in each of MoTel's exchanges. Although this tariff bears an effective date of July 1, 1991, MoTel requests expedited approval of this tariff since MoTel plans to make these custom calling features available in four of its exchanges prior to July 1, 1991.

On June 5, 1991, the Commission's Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum in this case recommending that the Commission approve this proposed tariff, as amended. Staff notes that, at its request, MoTel amended this tariff filing in order to clarify its provisions.

Based upon the recommendation of Staff and the provisions of the tariff proposed, the Commission determines that this tariff should be approved on an expedited basis for good cause shown. The Commission believes that the provisions of this tariff will be beneficial to MoTel's customers and should be made available to them on an expedited basis.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff submitted to this Commission by Missouri Telephone Company on May 28, 1991, and subsequently revised, offering a sixty (60) day waiver of connection charges associated with the initial offering of custom calling features be approved hereby for service on and after June 15, 1991.

2. That this order shall become effective on the 15th day of June, 1991.
