ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On September 23, 1994, Peace Valley Telephone Company submitted a proposed tariff designed to reduce its intraLATA access rates in compliance with the Commission's Report And Order issued December 23, 1992, in Case No. TO-92-306. The tariff proposes to maintain revenue neutrality for Peace Valley with the implementation of statewide calling plans.

On October 13, 1994, Commission Staff filed a memorandum recommending approval of the proposed tariff. Staff indicates in its memorandum that Peace Valley's tariff will comply with the Commission's decision and there will be a refund to GTE Midwest Incorporated as well as the rate reductions.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff and Staff's memorandum and finds the tariff should be approved as amended by a substitute sheet filed October 11, 1994. Based upon Staff's review, the tariff will bring Peace Valley into compliance with the Commission's Report And Order in TO-92-306 concerning revenue neutrality for local exchange companies following the implementation of the expanded calling scope plans.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the proposed tariff, as amended on October 11, 1994, filed by Peace Valley Telephone Company to reduce intraLATA switched access rates is hereby approved for service on and after October 23, 1994. The tariff sheet approved is:
