ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On January 22, 1991, United Telephone Company of Missouri (United) submitted a tariff proposing to implement community optional service (COS) from its Green Ridge exchange to the Sedalia exchange served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company. The implementation of COS on this route is pursuant to the schedule agreed to by the parties in Case No. TO-90-232 for the implementation of Phase II routes. Pursuant to that Stipulation and Agreement, United requests that the Commission approve this proposed tariff for service rendered on and after February 22, 1991.

On January 31, 1991, the Commission's Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum in this case recommending that the Commission issue an order approving this proposed tariff. Based upon the foregoing, the Commission determines that this tariff should be approved for service on and after February 22, 1991.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff filed in this case by United Telephone Company of Missouri proposing to implement community option service (COS) from the Green Ridge exchange of United Telephone Company of Missouri to the Sedalia exchange served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company to be approved for service rendered on and after February 22, 1991.

2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
