ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On June 6, 1990, United Telephone Company of Missouri (United) filed a tariff herein proposing to delete language referring to its Pleasant Hill exchange as an extended measured service (EMS) exchange. United proposes removing EMS from its Pleasant Hill exchange at the same time it implements community optional service (COS). The Commission has directed United to provide COS in its Pleasant Hill exchange on or before June 30, 1990.


The Commission's Staff (Staff) recommends that the Commission approve this tariff for service rendered on and after June 30, 1990. The Commission notes that United is requesting that this tariff become effective in less than 30 days. The Commission determines that it is in the public interest for the customers of United in the Pleasant Hill exchange to receive COS as soon as possible. Therefore, the Commission will approve this tariff for service on and after June 30, 1990, for good cause shown.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff filed herein on June 6, 1990, by United Telephone Company of Missouri to delete language referring to its Pleasant Hill exchange as an extended measured service exchange be approved hereby for service on and after June 30, 1990.

2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
