ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

On March 1, 1991, the Commission issued an order of implementation approving the provision of community optional service (COS) from Mid-Missouri Telephone Company's (Mid-Mo.) Nelson exchange to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's (SWB) Marshall exchange. On May 3, 1991, the Commission extended the date of implementation of the COS route to June 20, 1991.

On May 28, 1991, Mid-Mo. filed proposed tariffs to provide service on the COS route for which implementation was approved. On June 17, 1991, Mid-Mo. filed substitute tariffs reflecting the COS route involved and the proper nonrecurring charges. On June 17, 1991, Commission Staff filed a memorandum recommending the Commission approve the tariffs as amended for service on or after June 20, 1991.

The Commission will approve the tariffs pursuant to its order of implementation and the order in Case No. TO-90-232 approving the implementation of Phase II COS routes. The route in this case is one of the routes to be implemented in Phase II.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariffs filed by Mid-Missouri Telephone Company to implement service from its Nelson exchange to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's Marshall exchange be hereby approved for service on or after June 20, 1991.

2. That this Order shall become effective on the 20th day of June, 1991.
