ORDER


On June 25, 1986, the Commission issued its Order extending the interLATA access charge and intraLATA toll pools through August 6, 1986. The Commission issued its Report and Order in the above-referenced dockets on July 24, 1986, with an effective date of August 26, 1986. The Commission finds it is necessary to extend the interLATA access charge and intraLATA toll pools from August 6, 1986 to August 26, 1986, to provide for the interim period.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the interLATA access charge and intraLATA toll pools be, and are, hereby extended by this Order through August 26, 1986.
