At a Session of the Public Service Commission held at its office in Jefferson City on the 20th day of February, 1987.

#### CASE NO. A0-87-48

In the matter of the investigation of the revenue effects upon Missouri utilities of the Tax Reform Act of 1986.

#### ORDER

On February 4, 1987, Union Electric Company filed a Motion requesting a waiver from the filing of the 1986 calendar year data for its electric business. In support of its Motion, the Company states that Staff auditors are at the Company's offices compiling a 1986 cost of service study for the Company's electric operations and if the Company files the 1986 cost study on March 2, 1987, it would simply duplicate the work now being done by Staff. On February 13, 1987, Staff filed a Motion stating it has no objection to the Company's request for waiver.

The Commission determines that the Union Electric Company's Motion for waiver should be granted.

On February 9, 1987, Arkansas Power & Light Company filed its Motion requesting that it be relieved of the obligation to file the 1986 data which is currently due on March 2, 1987. In support of its Motion the Company states that the December 15, 1986 filing was based on cost of service data for the twelve months ending June, 1986, and there will be no cost changes between June, 1986 and December 1986, which could significantally change the estimated tax savings.

On February 19, 1987, the Staff of the Commission filed its "Response to Motion" opposing Arkansas Power & Light Company's request on the ground that the 1986 information should encompass the entire year since the data will include eight months of rates implemented as a result of the Company's last rate case. In addition, Staff states the December 15, 1986 filing did not reflect the use of the one CP allocation method ordered by the Commission in the Company's last rate case.

Having reviewed the Arkansas Power & Light Company's request and the Staff's response the Commission concludes that Arkansas Power & Light Company's request should be denied.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the Union Electric Company be, and it is, hereby granted a waiver from filing the 1986 cost information for its electric operations.

ORDERED: 2. That the Motion filed by Arkansas Power & Light Company on February 9, 1987 be, and it is, hereby denied. On or before March 2, 1987, the Company shall file the information prescribed by the Commission in this docket showing the revenue requirement impact of the Tax Reform Act on its 1986 Missouri jurisdictional operations.

ORDERED: 3. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
