# ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND ADDING A PARTY

On March 8, 2002, Sprint Missouri, Inc., doing business as Sprint, filed an application with the Commission seeking approval of an interconnection and resale agreement between Sprint and Premiere Network Services, Inc., under the provisions of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. Although Premiere is a party to the agreement, it did not join in the application. Because Premiere is a necessary party to a full and fair adjudication of this matter, the Commission will add Premiere as a party to this case.

The Act provides that an interconnection agreement must be approved unless the state commission finds that the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement, or that implementation of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed 20 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing or an application for intervention. The requirement of a hearing is met when an opportunity to be heard has been provided and

no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence.<sup>2</sup> In the event that no requests for intervention or for a hearing are received, the Commission may grant the relief requested based upon the application.

The Act provides that, if the Commission has not approved an agreement within 90 days after submission, the agreement shall be deemed approved.<sup>3</sup> Therefore, the Commission will proceed with this case expeditiously. The Commission finds that notice of this application should be sent to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Premiere Network Services, Inc., is made a party to this case.
- 2. That the Commission's Data Center shall send notice of this application to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.
- 3. That any party wishing to request a hearing or to apply for intervention in this matter shall file an application no later than April 4, 2002, with:
