ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On August 9, 2002, the Commission issued an order granting FamilyTel of Missouri LLC a certificate to provide basic local telecommunications services. That order also approved the tariff filed by FamilyTel as amended on August 2, 2002. The order bears an effective date of August 16, 2002.

Also on August 9, 2002, FamilyTel filed substitute tariff pages. These pages were not included in the Commission's August 9, 2002 order.

On August 14, 2002, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a supplemental recommendation stating that the August 9 substitute pages should be approved. Staff indicated that the changes remove language purporting to limit FamilyTel's liability for mishandling emergency calls. Staff stated that the August 9 substitute pages meet the statutory requirements and are consistent with other basic local tariffs.

The Commission has reviewed the substitute pages filed by FamilyTel and Staff's supplemental recommendation. The Commission finds that the August 9 substitute pages should be approved to become effective as directed below.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the substitute pages filed by FamilyTel of Missouri LLC on August 9,
2002, tariff file number 200200585, are approved to become effective on August 16, 2002.
