In the matter of AT&T Communications of the Southwest Inc.'s Tariff Sheet designed to provide an additional Thanksgiving holiday reduction in the 1-800 OPERATOR promotional rate.

ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEET

On November 15, 1993, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T) filed a proposed tariff sheet introducing a new promotional offering for its "1-800-OPERATOR" service. AT&T has requested expedited consideration of its proposal.

AT&T submitted the proposal to compete with various holiday promotions offered by other competitive companies nationwide. The proposed tariff sheet would reduce the current promotional rates for AT&T's "1-800-OPERATOR" service to a flat rate of \$.15 per minute unless a lower per minute rate would normally apply. In addition, the Operator Station service charge of \$1.00 and the Personto-Person service charge of \$2.35 would be waived during the promotional period of November 25, 1993 to December 5, 1993.

On November 19, 1993, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve AT&T's proposed tariff sheet. Staff stated that it has no objections to the proposed tariff sheet or to its approval on an expedited basis. Staff also recommended that the tariff sheet be allowed to become effective immediately upon Commission approval.

Upon review of the proposed tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that AT&T's proposal is reasonable. Thus, the Commission determines that the tariff sheet filed by AT&T on November 15, 1993 should be approved for service on and after November 25, 1993.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

 That the following tariff sheet filed by AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. is hereby approved for service on and after November 25, 1993:
