In the matter of the investigation of steam service rendered by Kansas City Power & Light Company.

ORDER

In its Report And Order in Case No. E0-85-185 and E0-85-224, the Commission created the instant docket for the purpose of investigating the future of Kansas City Power & Light Company's (KCPL) steam service, the appropriateness of its electric boiler program and the proper pricing of steam service. In the same Report And Order, KCPL was ordered to file its steam service plan with the Commission. In addition, the Commission stated in that Report And Order that based upon KCPL's commitment to no increase in steam rates prior to 1987, KCPL shall not file steam tariffs until 1987.

On June 2, 1986, KCPL filed its steam service plan, which proposes a phase-out of the steam system by December 31, 1990, and the conversion of steam service customers to on-site electric boilers or electric space heating. Attached to its steam service plan KCPL filed forms of revised tariffs and alternate phase-in tariffs related to steam service. KCPL states in its cover letter that mindful of the Commission determination that KCPL should not file steam tariffs until 1987, the revised tariffs have been filed without a proposed effective date pending Commission direction on the scope of the inquiry intended for the instant case.

The Commission, having reviewed KCPL's filing, determines that since KCPL is in a position to propose specific steam rates in connection with its steam service

plan, KCPL should file its proposed steam tariffs in the instant docket with a proposed effective date of January 1, 1987.

Upon the filing of the proposed tariffs, the Commission will establish an intervention deadline and a procedural schedule.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That Kansas City Power & Light Company shall file with the Commission its proposed steam tariffs in connection with its steam service plan. The proposed tariffs shall bear an effective date of January 1, 1987.

ORDERED: 2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
