

**ORDER DIRECTING UNION ELECTRIC TO FILE STATUS REPORT**

On October 31, 2000, the Commission issued an order granting Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE) a variance from Commission rule 4 CSR 240-13.015(1)(R). That order provided that the variance would not become effective until AmerenUE files, and the Commission approves, tariff revisions reflecting the variance.

AmerenUE has not yet filed a tariff revision reflecting the variance and the Commission would like to be informed of AmerenUE's intentions regarding the variance. AmerenUE will be directed to file a case status report informing the Commission of whether or not it intends to file tariffs implementing the granted variance.


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That no later than February 7, 2001, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE shall file a report advising the Commission as to whether or not it intends to file tariffs implementing the variance granted by the Commission in its order of October 31, 2000.

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2. That this order shall become effective on January 28, 2001.

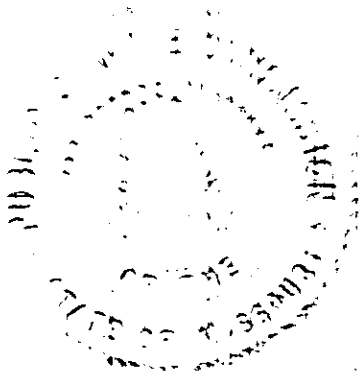
