ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF STAFF MEMORANDUM ON STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

Case number GS-2000-525 was established by the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) on March 1, 2000, for the purpose of receiving a gas incident report from the Staff of the Commission (Staff) and the response of Laclede Gas Company (Laclede) thereto, pertaining to an incident which occurred on February 7, 2000, involving a natural gas explosion and fire at 1904 Birchwood Drive in Barnhart, Missouri.

Case number GC-2001-19 is a complaint filed by the Staff against Laclede, alleging that in the incident set forth above, Laclede violated or failed to comply with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-40.030(14)(C), which prescribes the procedures for the

investigation and classification of gas leaks and for scheduling the repair of these leaks.

The cases were consolidated by the Commission on September 13, 2000, and a prehearing conference was held on October 18, 2000. As a result of discussions during and after the prehearing conference, Laclede, Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel filed their proposed stipulation and agreement (Agreement) on November 2, 2000.

The Agreement stated, inter alia, that the Staff may submit to the Commission a memorandum explaining its rationale for entering into the Agreement. According to the Agreement, each party shall be served with a copy of the memorandum and shall have the right to submit to the Commission a responsive memorandum served on all parties. In addition, the responsive memorandum shall be served on all parties within five days after the service of Staff's memorandum.

Thus, the Commission will order that a memorandum from Staff as set forth above be filed no later than December 6, 2000.

On September 19, 2000, the Commission ordered that a procedural schedule be filed no later than November 2, 2000. Due to the developments in this case, the Commission will order that the deadline for the filing of the procedural schedule be stayed until further notice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall furnish a memorandum explaining its rationale for entering into the proposed Stipulation and Agreement between the parties, filed on

November 2, 2000, the said memorandum to be filed no later than December 6, 2000.

- 2. That any party who wishes to respond to the said memorandum shall do so within five days after the service of the memorandum on the responding party.
- 3. That the deadline for the filing of the procedural schedule be stayed until further notice.
- 4. That this order shall become effective on November 16, 2000.
