ORDER DIRECTING STAFF REPORT

On March 23, 1999, the City of Fulton and Callaway Electric Cooperative (Applicants) filed their joint application for Commission authority to change electric service provider as to certain customers of each Applicant. On March 24, 1999, the Commission issued a notice of deficiency, noting that the joint application and its appendices lacked a certification that the same had been served upon the Public Counsel as required by Section 386.710.2, RSMo 1994. The Applicants filed their certificate of service on March 26, 1999, correcting that deficiency.

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall investigate the circumstances set out in the joint application and make a report to the Commission, including a recommendation as to whether or not the joint application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall investigate the circumstances set out in the joint application and make a written report to the Commission, including a recommendation as

to whether or not the joint application should be granted, on or before June 21, 1999.

2. That this order shall become effective on June 2, 1999.
