ORDER CANCELING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 3, 1999, Transtar Communications, L.L.C. (Applicant), a Texas limited liability company authorized to transact business in Missouri, filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services throughout the exchanges served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), GTE Midwest, Inc. (GTE) and Sprint Missouri, Inc., doing business as Sprint (Sprint). On April 6, 1999, SWBT timely filed an application to intervene, which the Commission granted by order issued on April 12, 1999. Also on April 12, 1999, the Commission set a prehearing conference for April 23, 1999, and directed that a joint proposed procedural schedule be filed by April 30, 1999.

On April 21, 1999, Applicant filed its Request for Cancellation of Prehearing Conference, stating that the parties are preparing a Stipulation and Agreement, which they hope to file by April 30, 1999. Therefore, the Commission will cancel the prehearing conference. However, the parties must file either a Stipulation and Agreement or a proposed procedural schedule by April 30, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the prehearing conference previously set for April 23, 1999, beginning at 10:00 a.m., is canceled.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on April 21, 1999.
