## **CORRECTION ORDER**

February 3, 1999, the Missouri Coalition for On Fair its Competition (Coalition) filed complaint against AmerenUE. Coalition styled the case in its pleading, "In the Matter of the Missouri Coalition for Fair Complaint of the Competition." Coalition's complaint against AmerenUE is necessarily a contested case style for such a case traditionally takes the form, "Petitioner v. Respondent." The Commission does not generally interfere with the styling of a case by the party that brings it; however, in this instance, because the style selected by the party is a significant departure from traditional practice and fails to name the respondent, the Commission will correct the style as set out above. The parties shall use the corrected style hereafter.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the style of this case is corrected to "Missouri Coalition for Fair Competition, Petitioner, v. AmerenUE, Respondent."

- 2. That the parties will henceforth use the corrected style.
- 3. That this order shall become effective on February 19, 1999.
