CORRECTION ORDER

On February 3, 1999, the Missouri Coalition for Fair Competition (Coalition) filed its complaint against AmerenUE. Coalition styled the case in its pleading, "In the Matter of the Complaint of the Missouri Coalition for Fair Competition." Coalition's complaint against AmerenUE is necessarily a contested case and the style for such a case traditionally takes the form, "Petitioner v. Respondent." The Commission does not generally interfere with the styling of a case by the party that brings it; however, in this instance, because the style selected by the party is a significant departure from traditional practice and fails to name the respondent, the Commission will correct the style as set out above. The parties shall use the corrected style hereafter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the style of this case is corrected to "Missouri Coalition for Fair Competition, Petitioner, v. AmerenUE, Respondent."

2. That the parties will henceforth use the corrected style.
3. That this order shall become effective on February 19, 1999.
