#### ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DELAY FILING OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

By an order issued on June 20, 2000, the Commission directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than August 1. On that date, the Staff of the Commission, acting on behalf of all the parties, filed a Motion to Delay Filing of Procedural Schedule. That motion indicated that all parties participated in a prehearing conference on July 25. During the prehearing conference, the parties discussed settlement options and it was unanimously agreed that more time was needed to discuss a settlement and to exchange information. The motion indicates that all parties agree that the filing of a procedural schedule should be delayed until October 2. The motion suggests that at that time the parties should either file a procedural schedule or advise the Commission when a stipulation and agreement will be filed.

The Commission has considered the Motion to Delay Filing of Procedural Schedule and finds that it should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Motion to Delay Filing of Procedural Schedule is granted.
- 2. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than October 2, 2000.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on August 14, 2000.
