ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

On May 17, 1991 Union Electric Company (UE) submitted tariffs designed to implement its Energy Efficient Lighting Research Program. These tariffs were filed pursuant to a Commission order issued April 11, 1991.

On June 3, 1991 the Commission Staff filed a memorandum recommending the Commission approve the tariffs. Staff indicates the tariff will allow UE to replace existing energy inefficient fluorescent commercial or industrial indoor lighting with new dedicated ballasts that operate only T8 fluorescent lamps. Staff also recommends that the tariffs be allowed to go into effect before the June 17, 1991 effective date.

The Commission finds based upon Staff's review that the tariffs comply with the April 11, 1991 order. The Commission will approve the tariffs to be effective in less than thirty days to allow the implementation of this program as soon as possible.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

 That the tariffs filed by Union Electric Company to implement Energy Efficient Lighting Research Program are approved for service on and after June 8,
 1991. The tariff sheets approved are:

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*ENERGY EFFICIENT LIGHTING RESEARCH PROGRAM

This research program is available only to commercial and industrial electric customers for facilities located in St. Louis City and the counties of Franklin, Jefferson, St. Charles and St. Louis.

Company will give a rebate of \$10 per ballast paid directly to customers who retrofit or replace existing fluorescent lighting with certain types of electronic ballasts and fluorescent lamps. New construction is not included in the program. The rebate will be issued to the equipment warranty holder upon confirmation of installation. Customers must purchase a minimum of 100 ballasts in order to qualify, and rebates will be limited to \$5,000 per customer.

Publicity will be given to this program primarily through intermediaries, such as lighting distributors and electrical contractors. Company will develop an informational brochure for customers.

The program will terminate on the earlier occurrence of: (1) budgeted dollars spent; or (2) November 30, 1991.
