ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO MODIFY ORDER ESTABLISHING TEST YEAR, ESTABLISHING DATE FOR FILING DIRECT TESTIMONY AND SCHEDULING EARLY PREHEARING CONFERENCE

- 2. That all other terms of the order issued January 21, 1999, by the Commission shall remain the same.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on January 25, 1999.
