## ORDER CHANGING TIME OF PREVIOUSLY SCHEDULED LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING

On December 1, 1998, St. Joseph Light & Power Company (SJLP) submitted to the Commission tariffs reflecting increased rates for industrial steam provided to customers in the Missouri service area of SJLP. On December 23, 1998, the Commission suspended SJLP's proposed tariffs. The case is set for evidentiary hearing on July 6, 1999 through July 16, 1999 at the Commission's office located in Jefferson City.

- 2. That St. Joseph Light & Power Company shall give notice to each of the Company's industrial steam customers at least fifteen (15) days prior to the local public hearing date.
