ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

The Commission granted Union Electric Company¹ (UE) and Gascosage Electric Cooperative's joint application for approval of a written territorial agreement on June 11, 1998. The order directed UE to file revised tariff sheets consistent with the territorial agreement. UE filed the required tariff sheets on June 24. On June 29 UE filed substitute sheets and by letter filed June 30, UE withdrew the June 24 filing and requested only the June 29 filing be considered by the Commission.

The Commission's Staff reviewed the tariff sheets and filed a memorandum on July 20 recommending that the Commission approve the tariffs as filed June 29. Staff stated that the tariff sheets comply with the Commission's ordered paragraph 2 and should be approved to become effective on July 31.

¹ Since the filing of this application, the Union Electric Company has been doing business as AmerenUE. However, for purposes of this order the company is referred to as Union Electric Company or UE.

Having reviewed the tariff sheets and the Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the tariff sheets filed on June 29 conform to the Commission's order and should be approved to become effective on July 31.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by Union Electric Company on June 29, 1998, are approved as amended to become effective on July 31, 1998.
