## ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On October 22, 1998, George Hoesch (Applicant) filed a motion to extend the procedural schedule in this case by moving all dates back by thirty days. On November 3, the Commission issued an order granting this On November 16, intervenor Missouri Department of Natural Resources filed a response to the November 3 order, in which it proposed certain modifications to the procedural schedule. On November 17, Applicant filed a Motion to Suspend the Procedural Schedule, in which it states that discussions regarding the subject of the application are ongoing, and that the application may be become moot. Applicant requests that the schedule be suspended for sixty days, and states that none of the parties to the case object to the motion. Since there is no opposition to the Motion to Suspend the Procedural Schedule, it will be granted. The Commission will order the filing of a new procedural schedule to ensure that the case progresses.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Motion to Suspend the Procedural Schedule is granted.
- 2. That the parties shall submit a new proposed procedural schedule no later than January 20, 1999.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on December 5, 1998.
