ORDER AND NOTICE

Teligent, Inc. d/b/a Delaware Teligent, Inc. (Teligent) filed an application on December 23, 1997, for certificates of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service, and local exchange telecommunications service in the State of Missouri under 4 CSR Teligent amended its application on January 21, 1998. 240~2.060(4). Specifically, Teligent wishes to provide facilities-based resold services in the exchanges currently served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, GTE Midwest Incorporated, and United Telephone Company of Missouri, d/b/a Sprint. Teligent asked to be classified as a competitive company and receive a lesser degree of regulation as permitted by Sections 392.361 and 392.420, RSMo.¹ Teligent requested a temporary waiver of 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H) that requires an applicant to file a tariff simultaneously with its application until it has executed interconnection agreements with the underlying CLECs and those agreements have been approved by the Commission. Finally, Teligent requested waiver of the following statutes and Commission rules:
