ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

Insurance Information Exchange, L.L.C. (IIX) filed an Application to Cancel Certificate of Authority on November 2, 1998, asking the Commission to cancel its interexchange certificate and tariff, issued by the Commission on October 6, 1997, in Case No. TA-98-71. IIX stated it had not provisioned service or invoiced customers in Missouri, that surrender of its certificate was not detrimental to the public interest, and that it wished to have its certificate canceled.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a Memorandum on November 9, 1998 regarding the proposed cancellation of IIX's certificate and related tariff. Staff stated it had reviewed IIX's application and had no objection to the Commission issuing an order canceling the certificate and related tariff.

Section 392.410 gives the Commission authority to cancel a telecommunications company's certificate of service authority. The Commission has reviewed IIX's application, Staff's memorandum, and the official file and finds that the interexchange certificate and tariff granted to IIX in Case No. TA-98-71 shall be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the interexchange certificate and tariff granted to Insurance Information Exchange, L.L.C. in Case No. TA-98-71 are canceled.
2. That this order shall become effective on December 1, 1998.
3. That this case may be closed on December 2, 1998.
