COMES NOW the Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri” or “Company”) and on behalf of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff) files this proposed procedural schedule pursuant to the Missouri Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) *Order Directing the Parties to File a Proposed Procedural Schedule* as follows:

Ameren Missouri inquired of all active parties¹ to this case and is not aware of any party opposing this procedural schedule with the exception of Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”). The Parties to this Proposed Procedural Schedule believe that it accomplishes the following: (a) Provides the framework to establish an evidentiary basis to support the Commission's ultimate decision; (2) is cognizant of witness and party availability, and (3) recognizes scheduling challenges anticipated due to pending cases this winter and also upcoming holidays.
