#### PROPOSED RULE

# 4 CSR 240-29.080 Use of Terminating Record Creation for LEC-to-LEC Telecommunications Traffic

PURPOSE: The purpose of this rule is to establish a system of terminating record creation between carriers for LEC-to-LEC traffic.

- (1) Terminating carriers may utilize information received from originating and/or transiting carriers to prepare category 11-01-XX records to generate accurate billing invoices for submission to originating carriers. All such billing invoices submitted by terminating carriers shall be generated and based upon category 11-01-XX records and such records shall be made available to the originating carrier upon request at no charge. Originating carriers are required to compensate terminating carriers on the basis of such accurate invoices.
- (2) A terminating carrier may identify the originating carrier that it bills based on the originating operating company number (OCN) associated with the originating caller identification number. Certain type I wireless interconnections may utilize blocks of fewer than one thousand (1,000) numbers; in such instances, wireless-originated calls may be attributed to wireline carriers. In the event that the terminating carrier, using the OCN identified in the local exchange routing guide, erroneously bills a carrier other than the originating carrier, then the carrier whose OCN was identified shall notify the terminating carrier, and the parties shall work jointly to identify the originating carrier.
- (3) Nothing in Section (1) above shall preclude two carriers from mutually agreeing to exchange other types of billing records.

AUTHORITY: sections 386.040 and 386.250, RSMo 2000. Original rule filed November 30, 2004.

PUBLIC COST: This proposed rule will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

PRIVATE COST: This proposed rule will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND NOTICE TO SUBMIT COMMENTS: Anyone may file a statement in support of or in opposition to this proposed rule with the Missouri Public Service Commission, Dale Hardy Roberts, Secretary of the Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, MO 65102. To be considered, comments must be received at the commission's offices on or before February 2, 2005, and should include a reference to commission Case No. TX-2003-0301.

If comments are submitted via a paper filing, an original and eight (8) copies of the comments are required. Comments may also be submitted via a filing using the commission's electronic filing and information system at <a href="http://www.psc.state.mo.us/efis.asp">http://www.psc.state.mo.us/efis.asp</a>. A public hearing regarding this proposed rule is scheduled for February 9, 2005, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. Interested persons may appear at this hearing to submit additional comments and/or testimony in support of or in opposition to this proposed rule, and may be asked to respond to commission questions. #### III. WORKSHEET

1. The Staff does not project a cost impact on any telephone company.

#### IV. ASSUMPTIONS

- 1. SBC claims the proposed rule will create a cost impact of \$1,898,623. SBC attributes these costs to two factors: 1) \$500,000 annually to hire 5 new employees and 2) \$1,398,623 for Information Technology development. These costs have been reduced to zero because SBC has already been mandated to develop the capability to bill intraLATA LEC Network traffic using terminating recordings. As noted in SBC's Accessible Letter Number CLEC03-346, the process of making switch recordings for all terminating and transiting LEC-to-LEC network traffic is already in place throughout SBC's 5-State Southwest Region.
- 2. Sprint claims the proposed rule will create a cost impact of \$400,000. Sprint's projection is based on developing a computerized process to accept and process industry standard category 11 records. Sprint further bases its projection on the assumption that the rule would be used by small carriers to "simply invoice Sprint for all unidentified traffic". Sprint's cost projections have been reduced to zero because Sprint already has in place a computerized process to accept and process industry standard category 11 records. Moreover, the rule does not allow any terminating carrier to simply invoice for unidentified traffic. Rather, the rule provides an option for terminating carriers to create industry standard category 11 billing records as a basis for creating accurate billing invoices. In no circumstance does the rule enable terminating carriers to invoice for unidentified traffic.
