**ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF CORPORATE NAME**  
**AND RECOGNIZING FILING OF ADOPTION NOTICE**

BroadSpan Communications, Inc. (BCI) submitted an Application for Approval of Name Change on December 30, 1998, designed to reflect that it will be operating under the fictitious name Primary Network Communications. BCI included with its filing a copy of the Registration of Fictitious Name from the Missouri Secretary of State filed November 18, 1998, and a tariff sheet with the effective date of January 29, 1999. At the request of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), BCI filed substitute tariff pages on January 7, 1999. Staff filed a memorandum on January 20, 1999, which stated that the Staff has no objections to the proposed adoption notice, as amended, and recommends that the Commission issue an order acknowledging the name change and approving the substitute tariff pages.

The Commission has reviewed BCI's filing and finds that the name change should be recognized. The Commission further finds that BCI has already filed an adoption notice on January 7, 1999, reflecting that fictitious name in its tariffs.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the fictitious name "Primary Network Communications" is acknowledged.

2. That the adoption notice denominated P.S.C. MO No. 1, Adoption Notice filed on January 7, 1999, by BroadSpan Communications, Inc., and assigned tariff file number 9900492, as substituted, is approved for service on and after January 29, 1999.

3. That this order shall become effective on January 29, 1999.
