# **ORDER SETTING HEARING**

On December 22, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a Staff Recommendation with respect to the Experimental Price Stabilization Program (PSP) of Laclede Gas Company (Laclede). Staff recommended that the Commission terminate the third year of the PSP, alleging that it is no longer appropriate in the current market conditions.

On January 5, 2001, Laclede filed its Response to Staff's Recommendation. Laclede requested that the Commission issue an order specifying that the company may continue operating under the PSP as previously approved by the Commission or, alternatively, take no action on Staff's Recommendation and permit the program to continue by its own terms.

On January 23, 2001, Staff filed a Reply to Laclede's Response. Staff continues to argue that the PSP is flawed. Staff also suggests that, if the Commission feels that it needs to take evidence and hear arguments, that the Commission hold a one-day hearing on February 2, 2001, or some other date in the first week of February.

Laclede filed a Response to Staff's Reply on January 29, 2001. Laclede reiterates its support for the PSP. Also on January 29, 2001, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a brief pleading noting that it supports Staff's recommendation to terminate the third year of the PSP.

The Commission has determined that prior to taking any action on Staff's recommendation, it requires additional information regarding the alleged deficiencies in the PSP and a more thorough explanation of the savings that have allegedly resulted from the PSP. In particular, Laclede shall be prepared to explain how it calculated the financial gains and savings it claims to have made. The Commission will schedule a hearing to allow the parties to present oral arguments on these topics. The parties should have appropriate witnesses available to answer questions, if necessary, from the Commissioners or the Regulatory Law Judge.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the parties to this case shall appear for a hearing on February 2, 2001, beginning at 8:30 a.m. The parties shall have appropriate witnesses available to answer questions, if necessary, from the Commissioners or the Regulatory Law Judge.
- 2. That the hearing will be held in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans With Disabilities Act. 3. That this order shall become effective on February 1, 2001.
