

**ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION**

The Commission issued an Order Opening Case and Directing Notice on January 11, 2000, which directed any party wishing to intervene or to file comments in this matter to file an application or their written comments no later than February 10, 2000.

On February 10, 2000, an application to intervene was filed by Adam's Mark Hotels, Alcoa Foil Products (Alumax, Inc.), Anheuser-Busch Cos., Inc., The Boeing Company, Ford Motor Company, General Motors Corporation, Hussman Refrigeration, Mallinckrodt, Inc., MEMC Electronic Materials, Inc., Monsanto Company, Procter & Gamble Manufacturing Company, Ralston Purina Company, and Solutia, collectively known as the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC). MIEC states that its interest in this proceeding is different from that of the general public and that intervention by MIEC will serve the public interest by assisting the Commission in developing a more complete record for decision. MIEC opposes the relief sought by Laclede Gas Company.

The Commission has reviewed the application to intervene from the MIEC and has determined that it is in substantial compliance with Commission rules regarding intervention and that the MIEC has an

interest in this matter which is different from that of the general public. The Commission concludes that the request for intervention should be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That intervention is granted to the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, which consists of Adam's Mark Hotels, Alcoa Foil Products (Alumax, Inc.), Anheuser-Busch Cos., Inc., The Boeing Company, Ford Motor Company, General Motors Corporation, Hussman Refrigeration, Mallinckrodt, Inc., MEMC Electronic Materials, Inc., Monsanto Company, Procter & Gamble Manufacturing Company, Ralston Purina Company, and Solutia.

2. That this order shall become effective on March 7, 2000.

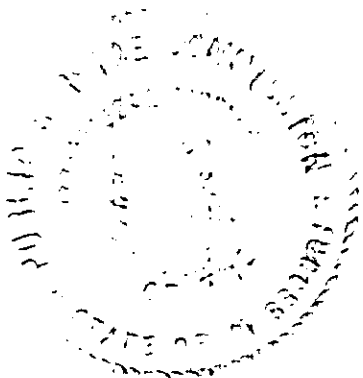
