ORDER APPROVING INTERIM BOWLING GREEN DISTRICT RATES AND VARIANCE REQUEST

United Cities Gas Company (United) of Franklin, Tennessee, submitted a REQUEST FOR VARIANCE FROM TARIFF PROVISIONS (Variance) and a tariff sheet to the Commission on January 28, 2000, carrying an effective date of March 1, 2000. The Variance will allow United to extend the time permitted by its tariff to collect the current balance in its Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) account over a 24-month period as opposed to the normal one-year period. The tariff sheet is also designed to reflect changes in the Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors for its Bowling Green District as a result of an increase in the spot market gas cost and the adjustment to its ACA factor. The net effect of these changes will decrease the Bowling Green PGA factor from \$0.4112 per Ccf to \$0.3725 per Ccf.

The Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum which recommended that the Variance filed by United on January 28, 2000, be granted and that the tariff changes made were reasonable. Staff further recommended that the tariff sheet submitted be approved, interim subject to refund, pending final Commission decisions in Case Nos. GR-99-280 and GR-2000-392.

The Commission has reviewed the Variance, tariff sheet, and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the proposed Variance should be granted and the tariff sheet should be allowed to become effective on and after the requested effective date, March 1, 2000, interim subject to refund.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Variance submitted on January 28, 2000, by United Cities Gas Company of Franklin, Tennessee, for the purpose of extending the permitted time for recovery of the current balance in its ACA account, in its Bowling Green District, be, and it is, hereby granted.
- 2. That the tariff sheet submitted on January 28, 2000, by United Cities Gas Company of Franklin, Tennessee, for the purpose of reflecting changes in rates for natural gas in its Bowling Green District, be, and it is, hereby approved to become effective on and after March 1, 2000, interim subject to refund. The tariff sheet approved is:
