ORDER DIRECTING FILING

Comm South Companies, Inc., doing business as Missouri Comm South, Inc. (MCS or Applicant), filed an application on April 21, 1999, for approval of an interconnection agreement (the Agreement) between Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) and MCS. The Agreement was filed pursuant to Section 252(e)(1) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act). See 47 U.S.C. § 251, et seq. On April 27, 1999, the Commission issued an order making SWBT a party and allowing interested parties to request a hearing or to participate.

On April 29, 1999, the Commission issued its Order Directing Filing, requiring Applicant to correct a deficiency in its application by May 21, 1999. On May 21, 1999, Applicant requested an extension of the deadline to correct its application to June 4, 1999. On May 25, 1999, the Commission granted the requested extension. However, Applicant has never yet corrected its deficient application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Comm South Companies, Inc., doing business as Missouri Comm South, Inc., shall, within ten (10) days of the date of this Order, correct the deficiencies in its application as previously

ordered by this Commission or the same shall be dismissed without further notice.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 2, 1999.
