**ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS REGARDING ADMISSION OF TESTIMONY
AND EXPEDITED TREATMENT AND REQUEST TO BE EXCUSED FROM
EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

On November 3, 2014, TradeWind Energy, Inc. (“TradeWind”) filed a motion requesting that the Commission accept the admission of the testimony of witness Frank Costanza and an accompanying exhibit, subject to an objection from Missouri Landowners Alliance, and excuse TradeWind and the witness from appearing at the evidentiary hearing. TradeWind also has requested that the Commission grant expedited treatment for its requests. No parties have objected to or opposed the requests. The Commission finds the requests reasonable and will grant them.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The rebuttal testimony of Frank Costanza, filed by TradeWind Energy, Inc. on September 15, 2014, is received into the record, subject to any objections to its admission by Missouri Landowners Alliance. TradeWind Energy, Inc.’s response to Missouri Landowners Alliance Data Request 2.1 shall be included with the testimony as an

attachment designated Schedule FC-1. TradeWind Energy, Inc. shall file the attachment in the Commission's electronic filing and information system.

2. TradeWind Energy, Inc.'s request for expedited treatment is granted.

3. TradeWind Energy, Inc. and Frank Costanza are excused from participating in the evidentiary hearing for this matter.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
