**ORDER STAYING PROCEEDING**

On June 28, 1999, Foremost Insurance Company (Foremost) filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) against the Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes, Recreational Vehicles and Modular Units of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Director), alleging that Director, purportedly acting in his official capacity but allegedly without legal authority, removed or caused to be removed the Housing and Urban Development seal from the pre-owned 1988 Clayton Mobile Home owned by Foremost. The Commission issued its Notice of Complaint on July 1, 1999, providing 30 days for Director to file an answer, or, in the alternative, to file a request for mediation. On July 13, 1999, the Director filed his Request for Mediation. On August 13, 1999, Foremost wrote a letter to the Commission, stating that Foremost agreed to mediation.

This proceeding will thus be stayed, pending the mediation process. The parties will be ordered to report to a mediator and to file reports thereon.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That this proceeding shall be stayed pending the mediation process.

2. That the parties shall report to Jim Levin, Director, Center For Dispute Resolution, University of Missouri School of Law, 206 Hulston Hall, Columbia, Missouri 65211, no later than September 13, 1999 to arrange mediation sessions.

3. That the Records Department of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send a copy of this order to Mr. Levin at his address as set forth above.

4. That the parties shall jointly file a report to the Commission stating the progress of the mediation no later than 3:00 p.m., November 1, 1999, and then at thirty (30) day intervals thereafter until this case is resolved, dismissed, or otherwise disposed of.

5. That this order shall become effective on September 13,  
1999.
