ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On September 3, 1999, AquaSource Development Company (AquaSource) filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Procedural Schedule. The Motion indicates that an order of the Commission, issued on August 2, required the parties to participate in a prehearing conference on August The parties were also ordered to file a proposed procedural schedule 26. no later than September 9.

AquaSource's Motion states that on August 26, AquaSource, The Village of Laurie, the Staff of the Public Service Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel met at the prehearing conference. At that conference the parties unanimously agreed that they wish to engage in further discussions regarding AquaSource's Application and that the filing of a proposed procedural schedule at this time is premature.

AquaSource's Motion requests that the Commission extend the date for the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule from September 9, to October 15. The Motion represents that all parties consent to this proposed extension.

The Commission is willing to allow the parties additional time in which to discuss these matters in recognition of the fact that further discussions may result in the amicable resolution of some or all of the issues in dispute.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Motion for Extension of Time to File Procedural Schedule is granted.

2. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than October 15, 1999. The procedural schedule shall include dates for the filing of testimony and for a hearing.

3. That this order shall become effective on September 17, 1999.
